# PROGRAM

## AWAKENING WONDER

The program will commence with what is essentially a learning sprint. There are two key outcomes: build relational trust to enable genuine collaboration and a shared experience to commence the project, and awaken participants' creative genius.

(Evening)

May 2022

A two-day face-to-face residential will launch the program. An informal dinner will be held on Thursday evening to ensure a timely start on Friday. This evening session will include a reflection upon the learning sprint, a presentation about the theory behind the experience, and the elements of high-performing teams.

The remainder of the two-day program will include further examination of the importance of relational trust, innovation, and creativity. References will be made to design thinking, the agile manifesto and agile practices, examples of iterative cycles of improvement, insights into motivation when undertaking complex work, and the importance of deep listening.
